We apologise for any inconvenience this causes. Thank you

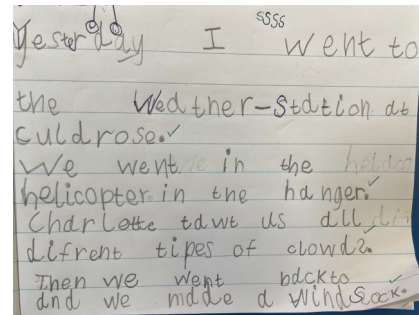
### Big Brush Club

## Sailor of the Week

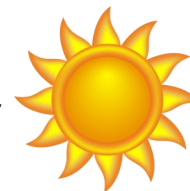
Sailor of the week goes to Ernie for mastering the technicalities of sailing.
