#### Attendance Update

**New guidance on attendance has been introduced from Sept 2022- 'Working together to improve school attendance'**

The new guidance makes it clear that if parents decide to have their child registered at school, they have an additional legal duty to ensure their child attends that school regularly. This means their child must attend every day that the school is open, except in a small number of allowable circumstances such as being too ill to attend or being given permission for an absence in advance from the school. This is essential for pupils to get the most out of their school experience, including their attainment, wellbeing, and wider life chances.

As a school we continue to work closely with the Educational Welfare Service to ensure that punctuality and regular attendance are encouraged, recognising that it is an important factor in developing a child's sustained and regular progress
