Thank you to everyone who made a food donation for the Helston and Lizard food bank.

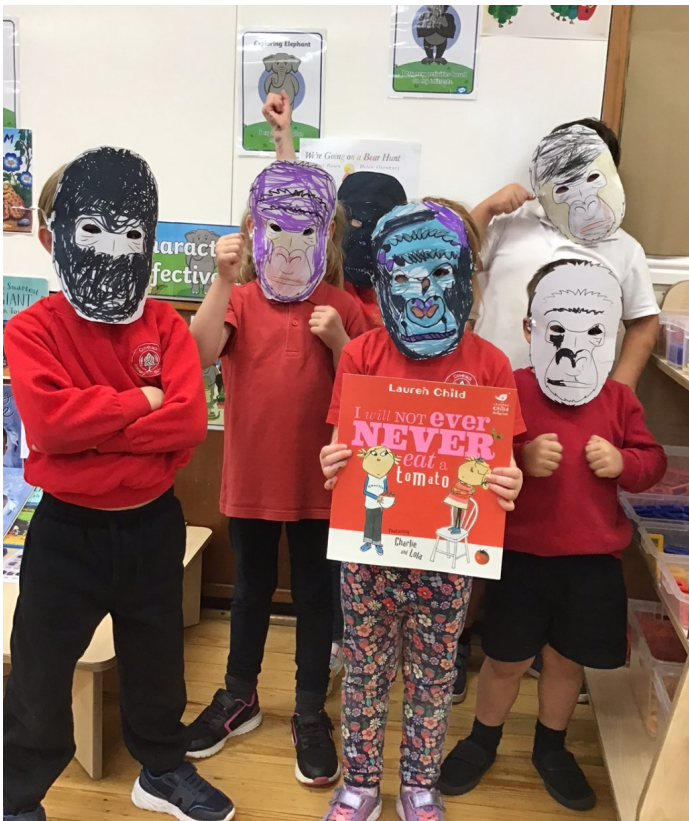
Apsens—Taster Session
