Heavy Cake Recipe

350g/12oz Plain Flour 2.5ml/1/2 tsp Salt 175g/6oz of Lard 75g/3oz caster sugar 175g/6oz currents A little chopped mixed peel 150ml mixed milk and water 1 egg beaten

Place the flour and salt in a bowl, then rub in the lard until the mixture resembles breadcrumbs, stir in the remaining dry ingredients. Gradually add enough milk and water to make a stiff dough. It will not take very much. Roll out on to a greased baking sheet to about 1 cm thick.

Glaze with beaten egg. Draw a criss-cross pattern on the top with the tip of a knife. Bake in a preheated over at 160 centigrade for about 20 minutes until golden. Allow to cool, then cut into squares.
